Welcome by Shaun

- 1. Carole Ann gave a brief data report and answered questions.
- 2. Website.

Shaun explained how the website has been improved now Rouge have updated some functions. There have been improvements made for Carole Ann in the dashboard functionality and an increase in speed of the site, especially on the Self Assessments. They have also added a "Welcome page" with choices for the User so they can access the self-assessment tool much easier. 4. AOB.

Staffan raised an important point that standards have an automatic systematic review every 5 years. This is to decide if the standard should be revised, kept as is or withdrawn.

ISO20400 and 26000 are linked and ISO 26000 will be reviewed this year and any proposed changes may affect ISO 20400 A new technical committee for social responsibility is being proposed by Afnor. Colin stated that so far there is no formal proposal to include ISO 20400 but the scope of the proposed committee is very broad and there could be a future proposal to include ISO 20400.

We are looking at employing freelance translators for when we need translations quickly. Although we would be grateful to anyone who could please read them prior to them being added to the ISO20400.org website.
