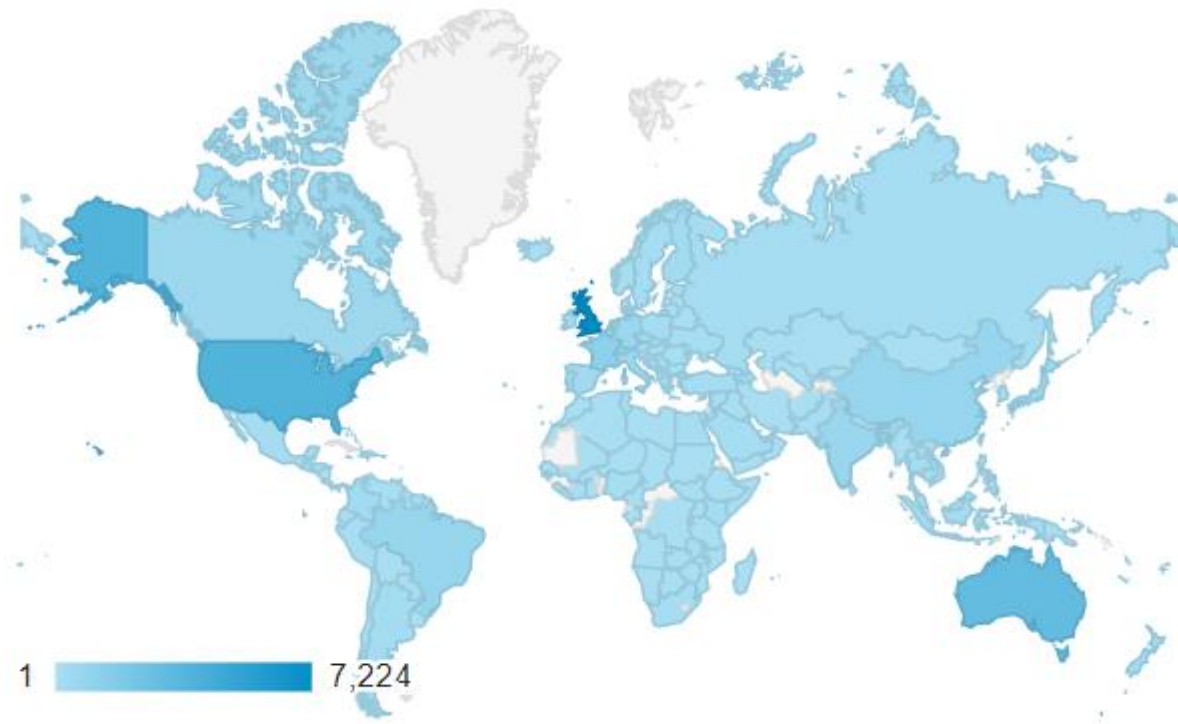

We have 7,224 users in the UK but as always the majority of our users are from the other 182 countries.

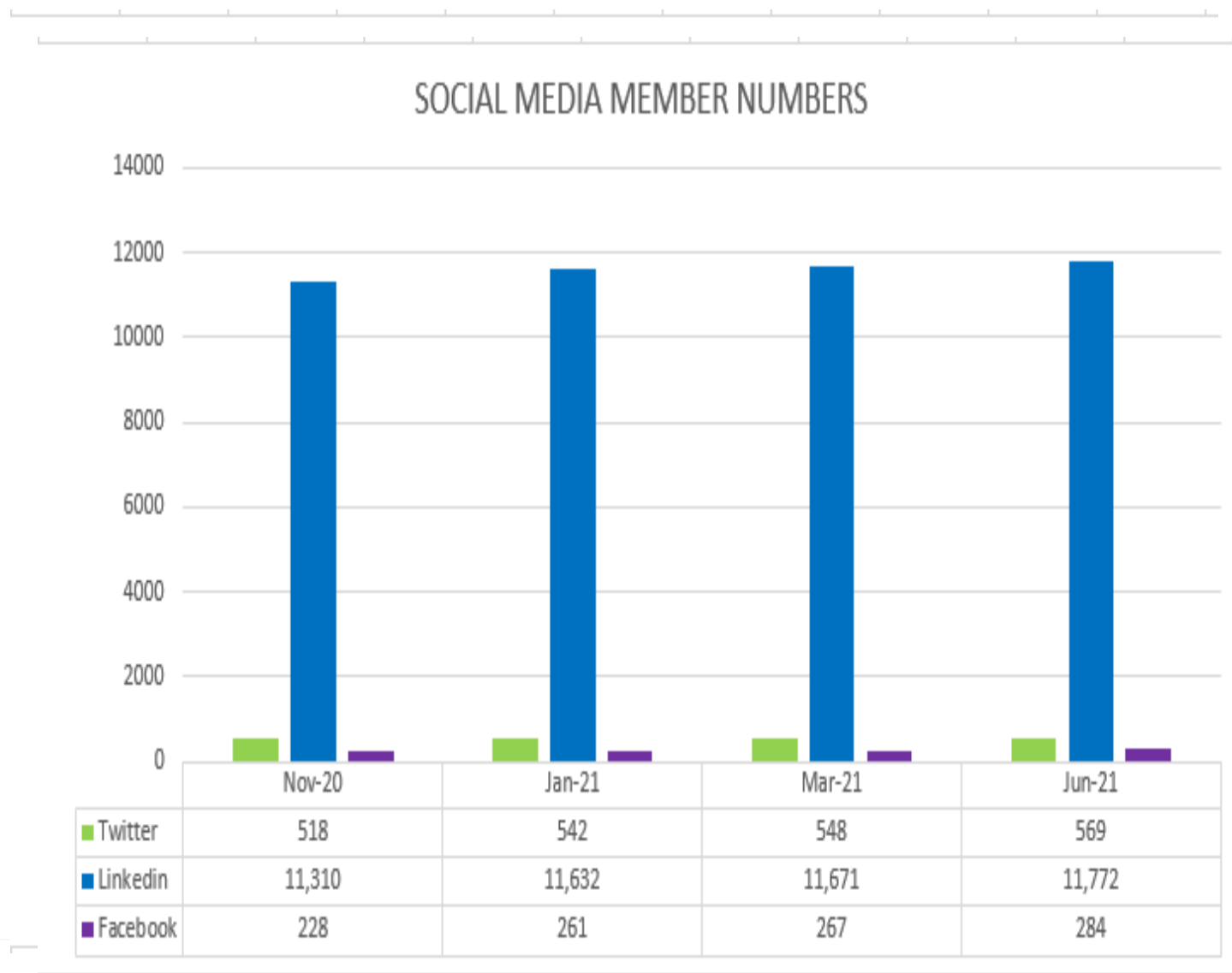

Plans for 2021 / 2022

We will continue to update the website, net work & market the website and resources via social media, communicate with you the Steering Group and deliver webinars.

We will continue working with Ross on his ISO 20400 / 2021 project. We hope to have this published and on our website very soon.

We are almost ready to update the website to include an interactive map showing clearly which countries around the world have adopted ISO 20400 as a national standard, which countries haven't but offer the standard for sale from their NSB, which countries use the ISO website to buy the standard and in what languages are available in each. This tool can be used to aid anyone around the world who accesses our website to clearly see where the standard is being used and where to buy it.

It could be used to encourage more countries to adopt the standard, to use the standard, with case studies it could highlight how countries which do use it are better environmentally / economically / social value

Focus on top ten countries on our website to get the biggest impact quickly ?

This "tool" can be offered to other ISO standards in the future ?

Preparing for 2022 when the ISO 20400 standard will be reviewed which we will participate in.
